Driving Tours

Apple Blossom Trail

Enjoy a self-guided driving tour in and around Henderson County's apple country to view the orchards in bloom. The apple trees produce gorgeous delicate spring blossoms waiting on bees for pollination to grow some of the best apples in Western North Carolina. The apple blossom varies in color according to the type of apple tree and is best recognized as white or pink. Three self-guided driving tours are available, ranging from 7.5 – 25 miles long. The apple blossom peak season usually runs from mid-April to early May. The apple harvest season runs from late August through October.

Dogwood Trail

Dogwood trees, the state flower of North Carolina, display beautiful flowers each spring. The popular dogwood tree is native to the eastern parts of North America. There are several varieties of the dogwood tree, some varieties are pink in color but most found primarily in the wild are white. The Dogwood Trail, a self-guided driving tour is 23 miles of beautiful spring blossoms, historic sites and lovely neighborhoods. The optimum time of year to view the dogwood trees is mid-April.



Crest of the Blue Ridge

American Viticulture Area

Henderson County's wine region has achieved the prestigious federal designation known as an American Viticultural Area (AVA). In July of 2019, the area was designated the Crest of the Blue Ridge Henderson County AVA.

Only regions that have distinctive soil, climate and elevation earn this designation. Warm days and cool mountain nights during the growing season, along with the right soil and water quality, provide favorable conditions for grape production in Henderson County. The county's rolling vineyards produce high-quality classic wines from European vinifera and French-American hybrid grapes, as well as sweeter wines crafted from grapes native to North Carolina.
